The St. Johns County School Board will ultimately select our school's name.

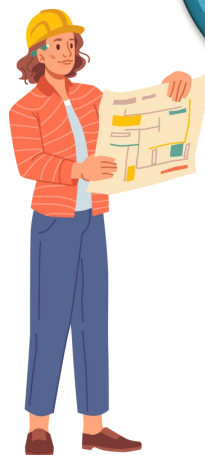
To ensure every suggestion is captured, all name recommendations from "QQ" families must be submitted through the survey. The survey window is Jan. 29 – Feb 1.

When making school name recommendations, consider local landmarks and regional connections.

It is important to note that proprietary names may not be used (i.e SilverLeaf Academy).

We cannot use any current high school or K8 mascot in St. Johns County.

The top 4–6 school names and mascot combinations will be identified based on survey recommendations.





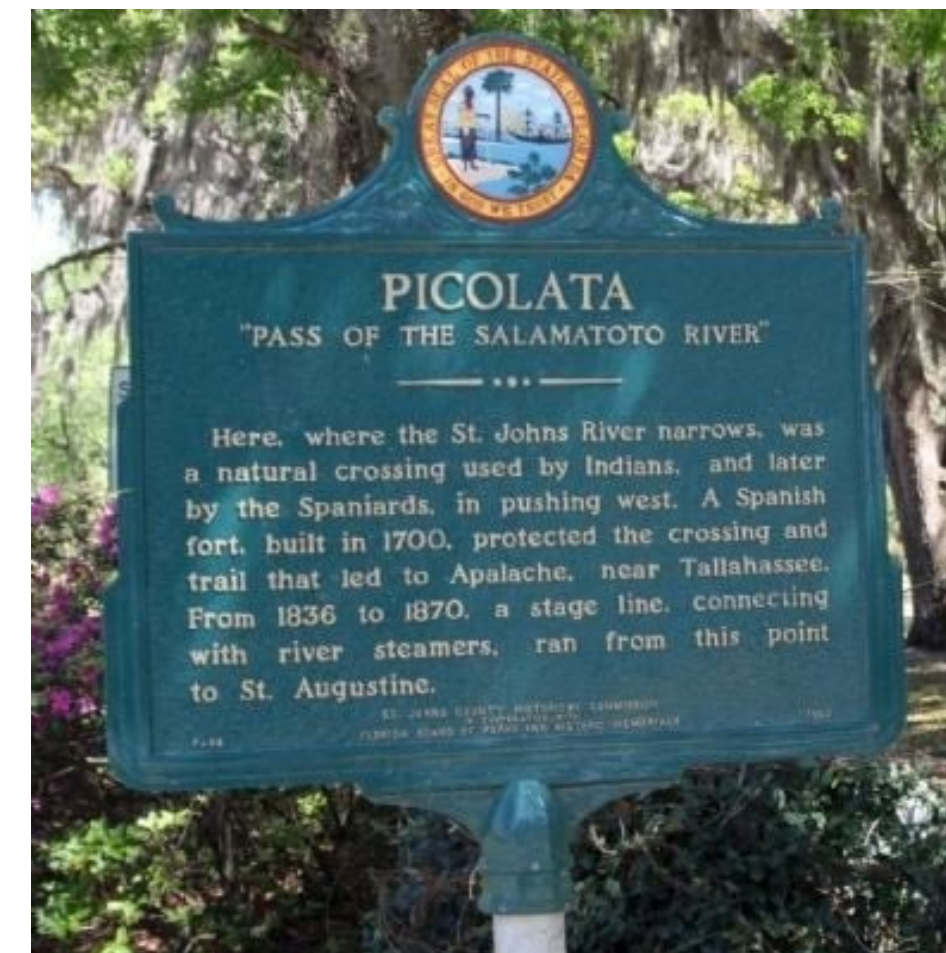
HISTORICAL RESEARCH

Dr. Cecilia Louise Fleming

Dr. Cecilia Louise Fleming (1862–1899), born enslaved on her family's farm in Hibernia (Fleming Island), lived in St. Johns County and began her career as a public-school teacher at School House No. 1, a Freedmen's Bureau school, eventually earning the title of "First Assistant." She became valedictorian of Shaw University in 1885 and later earned her medical degree in 1894 from the Women's Medical College of Pennsylvania, becoming one of its first African American graduates. Known for her dedication to education and medicine, Dr. Fleming also made history as a missionary to Africa, serving as a preacher, teacher, and doctor.

Salamatoto

Salamatoto is an ancient Timucuan tribe name and also served as the name of a primary ferry town for the Spanish. This name appears on historical maps and surveys for the area and was also referenced in 1624 by French explorers. The "Pass of the Salamatoto River" can be found in the Picolata area was used as a narrow passageway for the crossing of the St. Johns River for Native Americans and the Spanish.



HISTORICAL RESEARCH

Ponce de León & the Discovery of St. Augustine

- **Juan Ponce de León**, a Spanish explorer, arrived in Florida in 1513 while exploring the New World.
- He named the land "**La Florida**" after the Easter season, known as *Pascua Florida*.
- In 1565, Spain established **St. Augustine**, making it the oldest continuously inhabited European settlement in the United States.
- **St. Augustine** became a key **military**, cultural, and trade center for Spanish Florida.

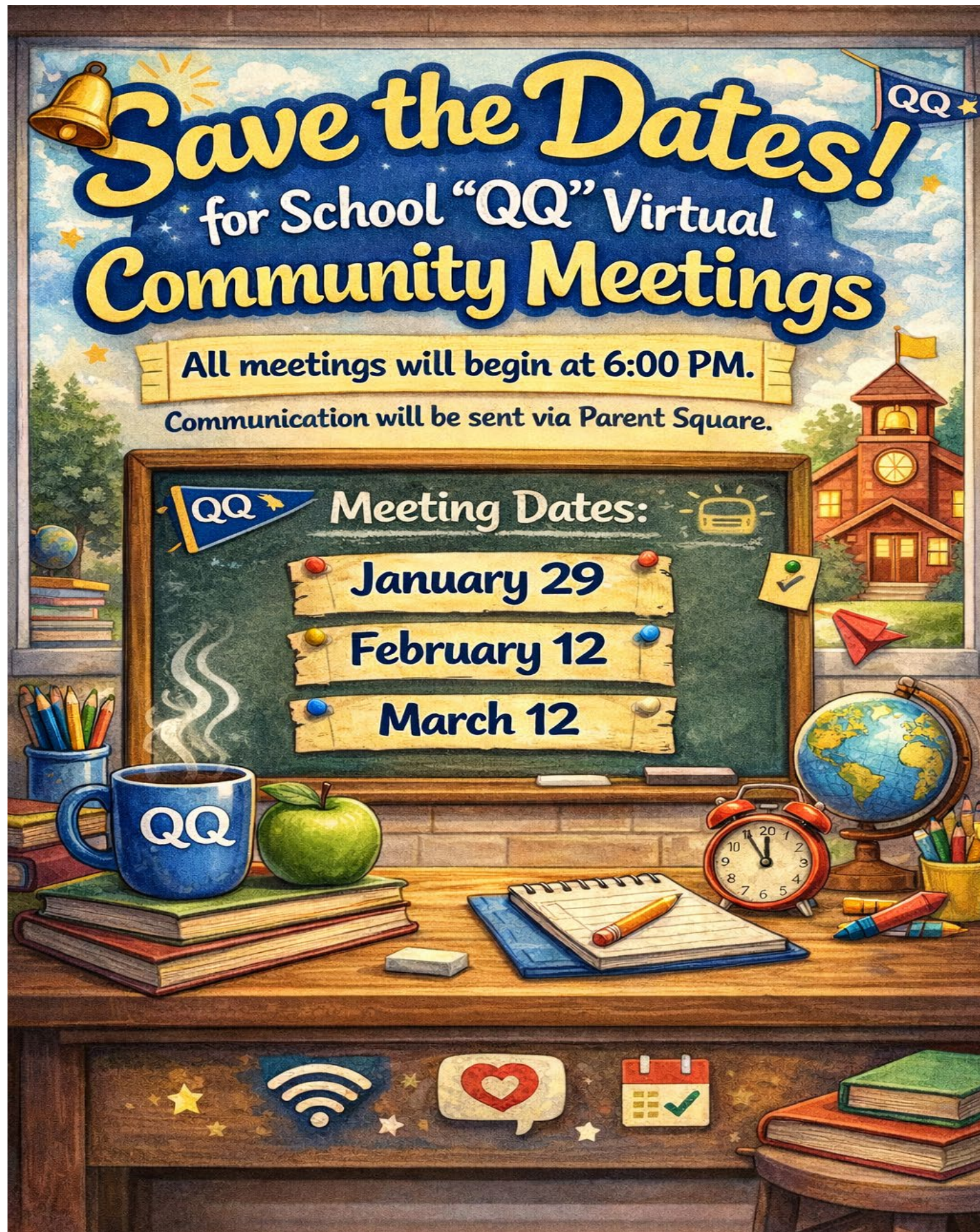
