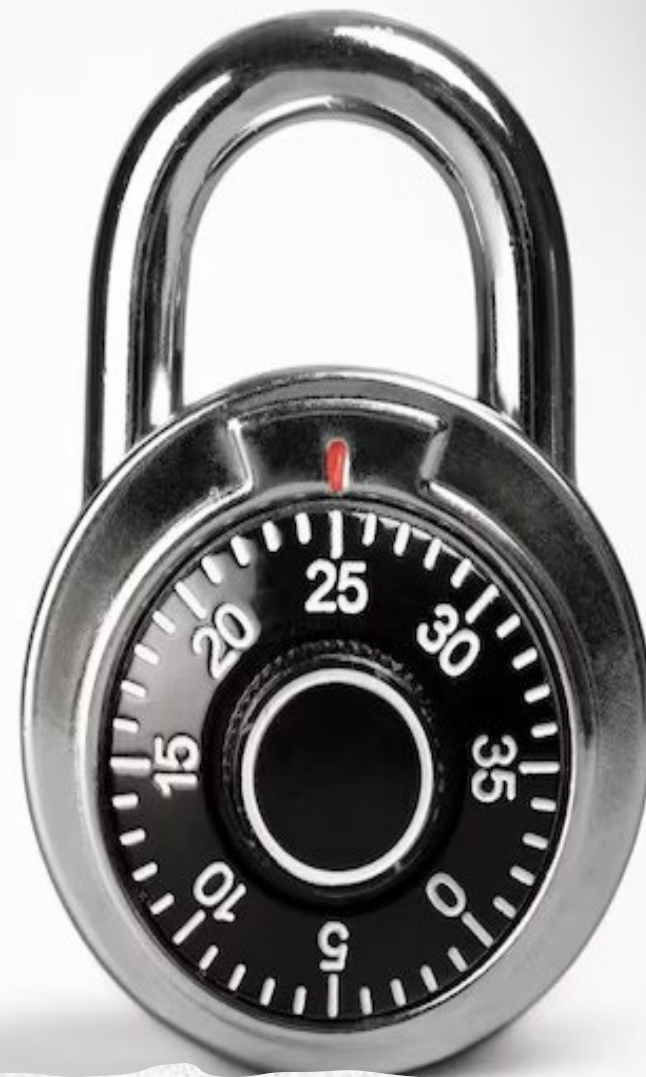
Arrival/Dismissal PPU Pattern

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT UPDATES



CELL PHONES

Students in elementary and middle school are restricted from device usage during the school day. They may have it in their possession, but cellphones cannot be in use during the instructional day.
(HB 1105)

BICYCLES, E-BIKES, AND SCOOTERS

Students riding bicycles, electric bicycles, or scooters to school must wear a safety helmet in accordance with Florida Statutes (F.S. 316.2065 and 316.20655). For their safety, students should never ride any type of bicycle, electric bike, or scooter on school grounds. Upon arrival at school, students are required to disembark their vehicle at the entry gate and walk it to the designated storage area. The same protocol should be followed when leaving the campus. Students are encouraged to lock these items in the designated storage area.

What is PBIS?

- Positive Behavior Intervention and Support
- PBIS is a proactive approach
- Improve student outcomes
- Support students behavioral, academic, social, emotional, and mental health
- Positive recognition, redirections, and reteaching of expectations rather than only punitive response measure
- Creates school-wide common language and expectations

Why PBIS?

- Proactive approach – encourages positive behaviors
- Safe and Predictable Environment – teaches behavior expectations
- Student Recognition – rewards and recognizes for following the expectations
- Creates a positive School Climate – positive school climates improve learning outcomes for all
- Preventative – stops misbehavior before it starts

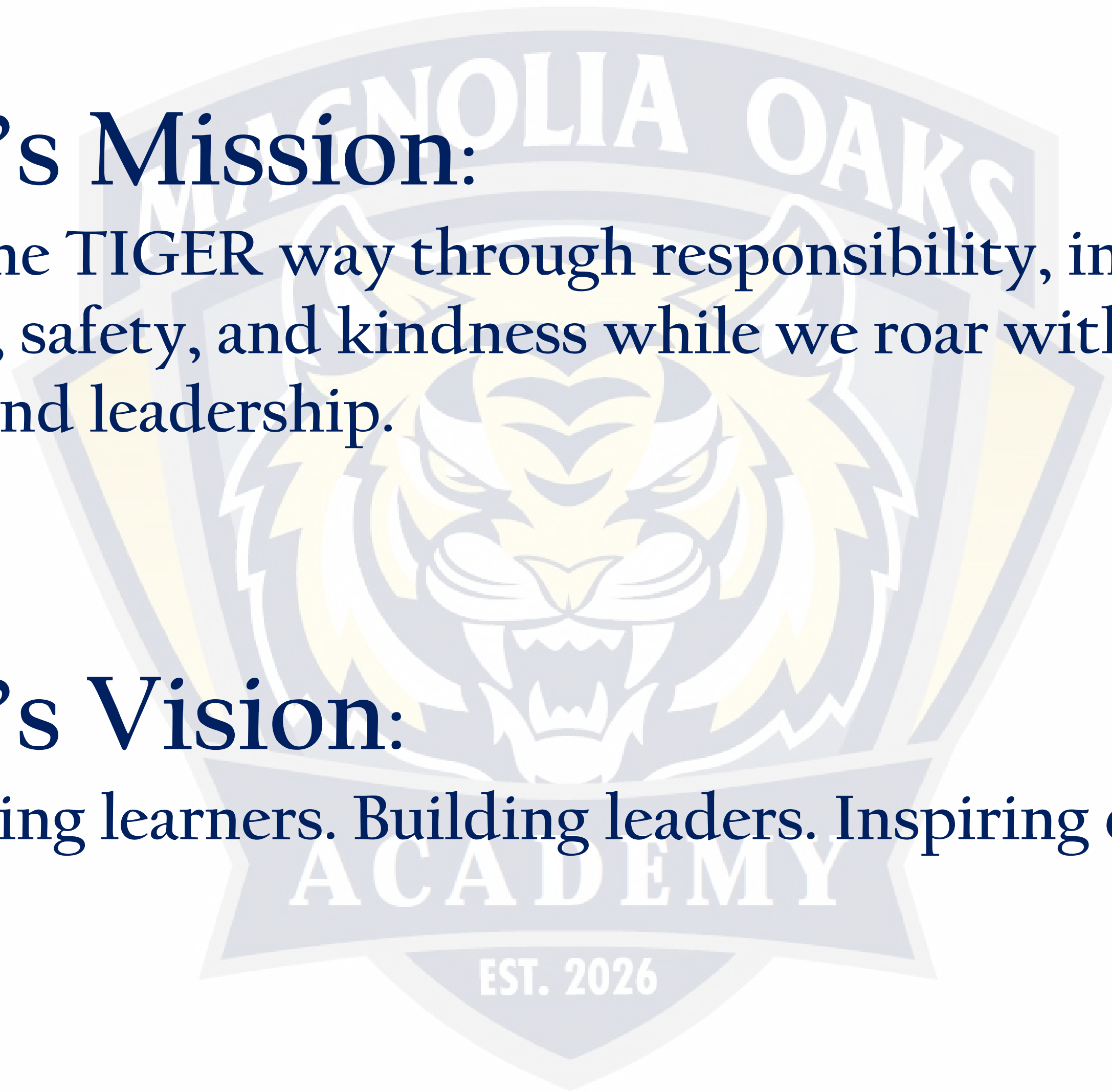
Mission and Vision
