Meet the Teacher Information:

- Thursday, August 6:
 - All elementary students will receive an email from the child's assigned teacher at 3:00pm.
 - Middle school schedules will be available in HAC. Your child's homeroom teacher will be their 1st period teacher.
 - Kindergarten and Access Point Self-Contained Classrooms Meet the Teacher will take place this evening from 5:30pm-7:00pm. If you can't make it the evening Meet the Teacher, you are welcome to attend the school-wide event on Friday to meet your child's teacher.
- Friday, August 7: Meet the Teacher for all grades

8:00-9:00	Students with the Last Names: A-J
9:00-10:00	Students with the Last Names: K-R
10:00-11:00	Students with the Last Names: S-Z
- Meet the Teacher Expectations:
 - Meet each teacher your child will have this coming school year. Multiple staff members will be around the campus to help direct you to your child's classroom.
 - KG, 1st, and some 2nd grade classes on the first floor
 - Some 2nd and 3rd-5th grade classes on the second floor
 - Middle school classes on the third floor
 - Bring all school supplies to drop off in your child's classroom. Kindergarten and 1st grade students, please provide a complete change of clothes in a zip lock bag with your child's full name on it to your teacher.
 - Visit the cafeteria before you leave for the following:
 - Get a parent pickup car tag for dismissal for each family member that might pick up your child.
 - Meet the cafeteria manager to add lunch and snack money to your child's lunch account.
 - Meet the school nurse(s) and drop off any necessary medication.

- Safety Patrols can pick up their patrol belts.
 - Submit all paperwork needed to complete the registration process (immunizations and/or residency) with our computer operators.
 - If you do not know who your child's teacher is or were not able to get their schedule from HAC, please see our computer operators.
 - For any extended day registration or waitlist information, please see our extended day coordinator.
- Middle school students: meet the PE coach(es) to purchase your PE uniform and/or PE locker if you have not purchased it already online via School Pay.
 - Visit our wonderful PTO to join PTO, purchase spirit wear items, or just learn how you can support MOA.

First Day of School: Monday, August 10

- Kindergarten students will participate in "Staggered Start" August 10-13. Kindergarten students will be assigned to **only** come on one of these first four days. All kindergarten students will attend together for the first time, Friday, August 14. Additional information provided on the "Kindergarten Staggered Start Information" document attached.
- Only kindergarten parents will be allowed access to walk their child to class on their child's staggered start day **only**. You must complete the online application ahead of time and be an approved volunteer to access the building. The link to the online application is located at <https://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/volunteer/>. Without being approved ahead of time, you will **not** be able to walk your child. On your staggered start day listed below, you will meet your child's teacher in the cafeteria at 8:20am. Please do **not** arrive prior to 8:20am as we will have the normal drop-off car line running prior to that time and parking spaces will be difficult to navigate then as well. You will be able to walk with your child and teacher to the classroom but will need to promptly exit the campus afterwards. The "Tears & TIGER Cheers" is a time for kindergarten parents to meet one another and hear information from MOA administration and our wonderful PTO. in our cafeteria at 8:30am, Friday, August 14. Again, you must be an approved volunteer to enter the campus.
- All students: For your child to be allowed to start school, you must ensure you have submitted all necessary documentation including immunizations and updated residency. You will be notified by the computer operators or your homeroom teacher if you need to provide any necessary documents to ensure your child can start school on the first day.
